We construct steady periodic water waves with multiple critical layers. The mathematical setting is that of the twodimensional Euler equations with a free top boundary; the corresponding waves are rotational gravity waves propagating over water of finite depth. Using bifurcation from a particular class of eigenvalues, some of which are not simple, we find i) waves with arbitrarily many critical layers and a single crest in each period, and ii) waves with several crests and troughs in each period.
