The classification of subfactors was started by V. Jones, and it developed dramatically, involving various other fields of mathematics. Existence of subfactors that do not come directly from other objects such as quantum groups was raised as question, and Haagerup gave the list of the candidates of graphs that might be invariants for such subfactors with index a little above 4.
