We show that generic Heegaard splittings give rise to hyperbolic manifolds, in the follow sense. If you take a random walk on the mapping class group, and use this as the gluing map between the two handlebodies, then the probability you obtain a hyperbolic manifold tends to one as the length of the random walk tends to infinity.
