We provide an example of a shellable polyhedral complex \mathcal{P} in \mathbb{R}^2 such that the module of continuous splines $C^0(\hat{\mathcal{P}})$ is not a free module over the polynomial ring in three variables, answering a question raised by Schenck in his paper Equivariant Chow Cohomology of Non-Simplicial Toric Varieties.
