An old problem asks whether a Riemannian manifold can be isospectral to a Riemannian orbifold with nontrivial singular set. We show that under the assumption of Schanuel's conjecture in transcendental number theory, this is impossible whenever the orbifold and manifold in question are compact locally symmetric spaces of nonpositive curvature associated to simple Lie groups.
