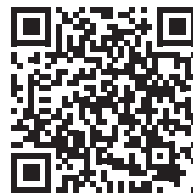

Gerrymandering

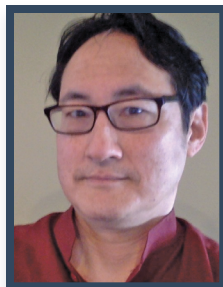
